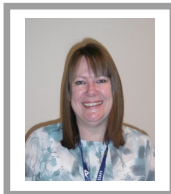
We strongly advise, that if you have any information to share, concerns or worries about your children you contact the class teacher first.

Miss Beckett is based at both school sites. Appointments to meet her can be made at the school office.



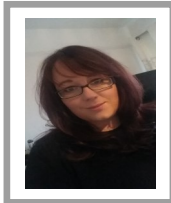
Mrs Snow

Miss Davenport

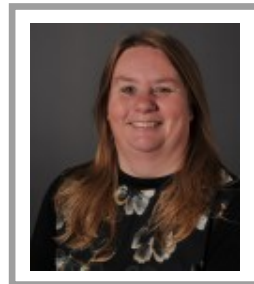
Head of Academy

Miss Davenport is in charge of the day to day running of the Academy

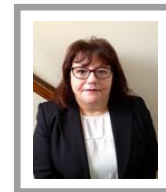
